## Parents Evening

Your child should have brought home a letter and reply slip to confirm a telephone appointment with your child's class teachers to discuss how they have settled back into school, the progress they have made so far and their next steps in learning. If you haven't received this, please telephone school so an appointment can be made.

### Arriving at School

Thank you for your support, patience and co-operation with the staggered start and finish times to the children's school day. As part of our risk assessment and safety measures, we are limiting contact between pupil bubbles. We therefore ask that you arrive at your allocated time and not before or after. This will avoid the opportunity for children to mix on the playground with others not in the same bubble as them and we can promptly get all children into class. For Y3/4/5/6 children, can parents please remain on the school playground/field so children can walk to the doors independently to be greeted by a member of staff. This will reduce the number of parents walking up and down the narrow paths. It is essential that all parents and children off at Forestwood School at the bottom carpark and will be walking the short distance against the one-way system to return to the carpark.

The nursing team will be in school on **Wednesday 21st October** to administer flu vaccinations to Reception— Y6 children. You must give consent for your child to have the vaccine.

#### Update on Scheduled Events in School

Any parents who have already begun to pay for this visit will receive a letter informing them how the money will be returned to them. We are still waiting to hear from Robinwood to confirm if the February visit for Y4, 5 & 6 will go ahead. We shall let parents know as soon as possible but ask them not to pay any more towards the costs of this visit until further notice.
