<u>Covid-19 Updates</u>

Staff in school will continue to be vigilant in adhering to the safety measures we have in place. We have recently worked alongside the Wakefield Public Health Team to ensure any positive tests have been communicated swiftly to parents and those children/classes identified as close contacts have been asked to self-isolate at home. Thank you for your co-operation in self-isolating.

We ask parents to adhere to the staggered start and drop off times to reduce the amount of people on site at one time. These are available on the school website. A big thank you to those parents who continue to maintain a distance of 2m from other households and wear face coverings whilst on school site.

Please note that we do have parents who are exempt from wearing face coverings and families that establish support bubbles.
