Christmas Events



As you already know, we have a covid outbreak in our Year 5 and Year 6 classes. A big thank you to our families for supporting school and taking their child for a PCR covid test. This has helped to slow the spread amongst these classes.



However, this does mean that we need to plan some upcoming events differently.

Please note changes in dates for some of the upcoming events.

This is to accommodate children who have been isolating at home.

Year 3, 4, 5, & 6 Concert - Unfortunately, the covid rates are too high to hold this event in the school hall. As an alternative, there will be an online singing concert via zoom on Friday 10th December at 9am. We would like any children who are isolating and as many parents/carers from these classes to join us for a festive sing song. I will be posting a Zoom link and safeguarding protocols for the event nearer the time via the school APP.

We are cautiously planning to hold our lower school nativity concerts in the school hall with a small audience. The risk assessment will be continually reviewed on the run up to the event. This does mean that if covid rates rise we will regrettably need to cancel the concerts. I shall confirm the concerts nearer the time. If we are able to proceed, the following measures will be in place:

- 2 tickets per child will be sent home the week before the concerts. Audience names will be
 recorded on entry. For this event, you must bring your ticket or you will politely be refused
 entry. Please do not share tickets with other families, only 2 tickets per child will be allowed
 into the hall. Any younger siblings or babies who attend will need a ticket.
- Seats will be socially distanced in the hall with 2 seats together. Both tickets for each child will be sat together.
- Masks or face coverings are to be worn in the hall at all times. Normal exemption rules apply.
 Masks will be available on entry.
- Hand sanitizer will be available on entry.
- All windows and doors will be left open so it will be cooler than normal in the hall (you may need to leave your coat on)
- Entry to and from school will be via the back hall door. Staff will be available on the day to guide you.
